
Removal

WARNING: Do not work on or under a vehicle supported only by a jack. Always support the vehicle on safety stands.


Raise and support the vehicle.

- 2 . Remove the muffler assembly.

- 4 . Remove the air suspension compressor.

- 5. Remove the air suspension compressor upper cover.



- 6. Disconnect the air suspension intake filter pipe.
- 7. Remove the air suspension muffler.
 - Release clip from the air suspension muffler pipe.
 - Release the air suspension compressor to air suspension silencer pipes.



Installation

1 . Install the air suspension muffler.

Locate the air suspension muffler pipes.

Secure the clip.

2. Connect the air suspension intake filter.



CAUTION: Make sure the air suspension compressor upper cover is correctly positioned.
