A B MAIN SERVICE (VEHICLE INTERIOR)

1. Check condition and security of seats and seatbelts
2. Check operation of all lamps, horns and warning indicators
3. Check operation of front/rear wipers and washers and condition of wiper blades
4. Select the LOW range gears and drive the vehicle 3 to 4 vehicle lengths then re-select HIGH range gears
5. Replace pollen filter

MAIN SERVICE (VEHICLE EXTERIOR)

6. Check tyre pressures, condition and tread depth
7. Remove road wheels
8. Inspect brake pads for wear, calipers for leaks and disks for condition
9. Replace brake fluid (**Every 3 years**)*
10. Renew fuel filter element (**Diesel**)
11. Drain fuel sedimentor (**Diesel**)
12. Refit road wheels to opposite sides of the same axle (Use anti-seize compound on spigot bore) **Not vehicles fitted with uni-directional tyres**
13. Check operation of door checks, bonnet catch & fuel flap and lubricate door checks
14. Apply lubricant to door seals - **Nordic markets only**
15. Check condition of removable towbar

MAIN SERVICE (UNDER BONNET)

16. Check anti-freeze specific gravity
17. Renew coolant (**Every 10 years**)
18. Renew spark plugs
19. Renew air cleaner element (**Petrol Normally Aspirated**)
20. Renew air cleaner element (**Petrol Supercharged**)
21. Renew air cleaner element (**3.0L Diesel**)
22. Check condition of ancillary driving belts
23. Renew supercharger driving belt (**Petrol Supercharged Every 7 years**)
24. Renew ancillary driving belts (**except 3.0L Diesel Every 10 years**)
25. Renew ancillary driving belts (**3.0L Diesel Every 10 years**)
26. Renew front and rear camshaft timing belts, tensioners and tensioner bolt (**3.0L Diesel Every 7 years**)
27. Check/top-up brake, PAS and Dynamic Response fluid levels and screen washer reservoirs
28. Check/top-up battery electrolyte level - **low maintenance battery fitted**
29. Renew engine oil and filter
30. Clear debris from auxiliary oil cooler

A B MAIN SERVICE (UNDER VEHICLE)

31. Renew automatic transmission oil and filter (**except 3.0L Diesel Every 10 years**)
32. Renew automatic transmission oil and filter (**3.0L Diesel Every 10 years**)
33. Renew transfer box oil, replace drain and fill plug washers (**except 3.0L Diesel**)
34. Renew transfer box oil, replace drain and fill plug washers (**3.0L Diesel**)

A B MAIN SERVICE (UNDER VEHICLE)

35. Renew front and rear non-locking differential oil (**Every 10 years**)
36. Renew locking differential oil (**except 3.0L Diesel**)
37. Renew locking differential oil (**3.0L Diesel**)
38. Check for free play in all suspension and body mounting rubbers
39. Check condition of all suspension, driveshafts and steering boots and gaiters
40. Replace all flexible brake hoses (**Every 6 years**)*
41. Check visually brake servo hose, brake, fuel, PAS and Dynamic Response pipes, unions, and electrical harnesses for chafing, leaks and corrosion
42. Remove any debris from between the Dynamic Response valve block and the integrated body frame
43. Replace Dynamic Response filter in valve block and replace lost fluid (**except 3.0L Diesel**)
44. Replace Dynamic Response filter in valve block and replace lost fluid (**3.0L Diesel**)
45. Adjust the electric park brake shoes
46. Check for fluid leaks
47. Check exhaust system for leaks, security and damage
48. Check steering rod ball joint fixings and condition of ball joints and dust covers
49. If fault lamp(s) are illuminated, interrogate that system using IDS/SDD and report findings*
50. Carry out road test (**see WARNING over page**)
51. Reset service interval announcement indicator
52. Reset oil level indicator (if fitted)
53. Endorse service record
54. Check for any applicable outstanding service actions or recalls
55. Report any unusual features of vehicle condition and additional work required

The maintenance items listed, are those recommended for vehicles operating under normal driving, road and climatic conditions. More frequent attention may be necessary if the vehicle is subject to stop/start operation, extremes of temperature, dusty conditions, off road driving or frequent towing of trailers.
